## S I M P L E W A Y S T O REDUCE PRINTING COSTS

During the course of a year, the average employee prints 8,874 pages, ${ }^{1}$ and $17 \%$ of them will go unread. As the volume of information and data becomes a more central aspect of Impact's business processes, so does our focus on printing costs to keep up with employee habits concerning traditional non-digital handling of this information-in other words; people print more than ever. Today, organizations spend approximately $1-3 \%^{2}$ of annual revenue on printing, and this will continue climbing.

## 1 AVOID USING PERSONAL PRINTERS

Multi-function printers (MFPs) are specifically designed for offices. As opposed to standard consumer printers, MFPs use lasers and toner, a much more efficient method for printing. This means your cartridges will last longer than they would in a traditional device. If possible, shift every employee into using an MFP.

2 USE BLACK \& WHITE
Per page, a black and white document will set you back an average of five cents.
For color, it's about 2-3 times as much at 10-15 cents. ${ }^{3}$ The math is quite simple on this one; don't print with color unless you really need to.

## 3 PRINT ON BOTH SIDES

Printing one-sided is a common habit that costs businesses a lot. Establish office policies for printing on both sides unless one-sided is necessary, it'll instantly cut your ink costs in half.


4 SCAN MORE, COPY LESS
Rather than copying a physical document to give to someone, consider moving towards ubiquitous scanning. Use an MFP to scan and email documents, and save yourself printing costs as a consequence.

## 5 GO DIGITAL

In a similar vein, transition as much documentation as you can to online repositories like Dropbox and Google Drive. Not only will you be drastically saving on printing costs by removing the need to print, you'll also be establishing a digitized workflow for your documents, which can be stored, secured and shared more effectively than any physical counterpart.

## 6 USE ECONOMIC FONTS

This is a small but effective change that many are unaware of. Are you aware that the Arial font costs $27 \%$ more to use than Times New Roman? ${ }^{4}$

This is because of the style, size and shape of the individual letters.
By simply changing fonts, you can cut a very significant cost.


## 7 CHANGE YOUR HABITS

Do you really need to print that document, or are you doing it out of habit? We started this piece by indicating over $15 \%$ of all printed paper goes unread-that's a substantial amount that is caused by habits alone. Be more mindful of what you're printing and why, and save yourself money by doing so.

## 8 ADOPT AN MPS SOLUTION
